AN ACT

Relating to Clerical Assistance in the Office of the Register of Probate and Insolvency for the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The register of probate and insolvency for
2 the county of Middlesex shall be allowed, in
3 addition to the amount now allowed by law, a
4 sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars per
5 annum, from and after the first day of July, in
6 the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
7 three, for clerical assistance actually performed;
8 to be paid from the treasury of the county of
9 Middlesex, upon the official certificate of said
10 register countersigned by the judge of probate
11 and insolvency for said county.
