AN ACT REQUIRING JUVENILE OFFENDERS TO BE FINGERPRINTED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 119 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 67 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 67A.* Whenever a child between seven and seventeen
- 4 years of age is arrested, the officer in charge of the jail or town
- 5 lockup to which he has been taken shall cause him to be finger-
- 6 printed.
