## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty.

An Act providing for the Furnishing of Information to Municipalities in the Metropolitan Districts relative to the Amount of Assessments to be made upon Said Municipalities for New State Projects and Undertakings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section thirty-five the  
3 following new section:— *Section 35A.* Reports of  
4 state officers, departments or heads thereof, and spe-  
5 cial commissions recommending the expenditure of  
6 money for new projects and undertakings, any part  
7 of the cost of which is to be assessed upon cities and  
8 towns in the metropolitan districts, shall be accom-  
9 panied by a statement showing the amount, in  
10 dollars and cents, that would be assessed upon each  
11 city and town if such recommendation should be  
12 carried out. The officer, department or special com-  
13 mission making a recommendation as aforesaid shall,  
14 upon the filing of its report, send a copy of said state-  
15 ment to each city and town subject to such assess-  
16 ment.
