### AN ACT

To authorize Guardians to purchase Annuities, and making further Provisions relating to the appointment of Guardians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1.   The probate court, on the application of  
2 a guardian of an insane person or of any person in-  
3 terested in the estate of an insane ward, after notice  
4 to all persons interested therein, may authorize or re-  
5 quire such guardian to appropriate the property of  
6 such ward or such part thereof as the court shall  
7 judge proper, to the purchase of an annuity for the  
8 support of such ward, and make such further order  
9 in relation thereto as the case may require.

1   SECT. 2. Upon the resignation, death or removal  
2 of a guardian, appointed in this state, of a minor or  
3 insane person, if a longer guardianship is necessary,  
4 another may be appointed in his stead by the probate  
5 court of the same county in which the original guard-  
6 ianship was granted or in the county in which said  
7 minor or insane person shall then dwell.

1   SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
