AN ACT CREATING A STATE FUNDED AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, there  
2 shall be within the division of insurance a state funded auto-  
3 mobile insurance program providing property protection insur-  
4 ance coverage.
