The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO THE COMMISSIONER OF AIRPORT MANAGEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 50C of chapter 90 of the
2 General Laws, inserted by section 3 of chapter 637 of
3 the acts of 1948, is hereby amended by adding at
4 the end the following paragraph: —

5 One of the assistants provided for herein shall be
6 designated as an administrative assistant, and shall
7 be classified by the division of personnel, as provided
8 in section forty-five of chapter thirty, at the salary
9 as presently established by the state airport manage-
10 ment board, but shall not be subject to the provisions
11 of chapter thirty-one. Said position shall, however,
12 be subject to the applicable provisions of chapter
13 thirty-two. He may be removed as provided for in
14 section fifty-nine B of chapter six.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of Janu-
2 ary first, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.
