RESOLVE FURTHER CONTINUING THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE WATER RESOURCES COMMISSION OF THE GROUND WATER RESOURCES IN THE COUNTIES OF PLYMOUTH AND BRISTOL AND IN CERTAIN TOWNS IN THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK.

1 *Resolved*, That the water resources commission is hereby au-
2 thORIZED and directed to continue further the investigation and
3 study authorized by chapter three hundred and fourteen of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, the time for comple-
5 tion of which was most recently extended and the scope of which
6 was increased by chapter eighty-three of the resolves of nineteen
7 hundred and fifty-nine, relative to the ground water supplies in
8 the counties of Plymouth and Bristol and in the towns of Avon,
9 Holbrook, Plainville and Stoughton in the county of Norfolk,
10 and the question of how the municipalities in said areas acting
11 either individually or jointly may best utilize such supplies for
12 water supply purposes. Said commission shall file its final report
13 with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last
14 Wednesday of December in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-
15 three.
