**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PRACTICES, POLICIES AND GENERAL CONCEPT OF ADULT EDUCATION IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study of the practices, policies and general concept of adult  
6 education in the commonwealth. Said commission shall file an  
7 interim report not later than the last Wednesday of January,  
8 nineteen hundred and seventy-four and its final report not later  
9 than the last Wednesday of June, nineteen hundred and  
10 seventy-four.
