*Speaker of the House of Representatives :*

Agreeably to the request of Charles W. Storey, I herewith transmit to you a tabular statement of the amount of money paid annually, to each of the commissioners of the county of Worcester, for services rendered in such capacity during the last ten years. In making up said table, I have had recourse to orders to pay the commissioners, from the clerk of the courts, on file in the county treasurer's office. It will be seen, by referring to statement marked (A), accompanying the table, that there is no uniformity, as to time, with our commissioners, in the settlement of their accounts. In one or two instances, a settlement was delayed for more than a year. I have included the orders paid for eleven years, as affording a fairer average for the ten years required. A few of the orders to pay the commissioners read "for services as commissioner, and disbursements made by him in behalf of the county." The amount of such disbursements, and the amount paid for services rendered rail-road corporations and others by them, I have no means of ascertaining.
