AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHAPTER 40B HOUSING, SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 No applications shall be received pursuant to section 21 of chapter 40B of the General Laws until such time as the
- 2 office of the inspector general completes an audit being conducted by the office of the program established by
- 3 sections 20 to 23 inclusive is complete and a review of the profit levels of developers employing such program is
- 4 undertaken by the office of the general court.
