### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE OPEN BURNING OF LEAVES BY CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS DURING A LIMITED PERIOD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter III of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 142I the following section:—
- 3 *Section 142J.* Notwithstanding any provision of sections 142A
- 4 and 142B or any other provision of law, cities and towns with a
- 5 population of less than forty thousand persons may conduct, under
- 6 supervision of the fire department, the open burning of leaves
- 7 during the daylight hours of the last two weeks of October.
