AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE ISSUANCE TO RESIDENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHILE IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES OF SPECIAL CERTIFICATES WITHOUT FEE ENTITLING THEM TO HUNT AND FISH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 554 of the acts of 1968 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 2, as amended by chapter 733 of
3 the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

1 SECTION 2. This act shall cease to be effective on January
2 the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
