AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN CATEGORIES OF PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 130 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 83 and replacing it with the following new section: —

3 *Section 83.* For the purposes of defraying the cost of the divi-
4 sion's research, management and other activities, including admin-
5 istrative and operating expenses, and the costs of issuing certain
6 permits and the inspection relative thereto, resident and non-resi-
7 dent fees, the amount of which shall be determined annually by the
8 commissioner of administration under the provision of section
9 three B of chapter seven for the filing thereof, shall be paid to the
10 director by the person to whom the same is issued for any calendar
11 year or part thereof.

- 19 F. Individual (including rod and reel and shellfish)
- 20 G. Seasonal lobster

21 DEALER PERMIT

- 22 A. Wholesale dealer (any wholesaler dealing in fresh or raw
23 fish)
24 B. Retail dealer (any retailer dealing in fresh or raw fish)

25 SPECIAL PERMIT

- 26 A. Non-commercial lobster
27 B. Regulated fishery
28 C. Bait (contaminated soft shell)
29 D. Other

30 DUPLICATE PERMIT

- 31 A. Duplicate (replacing original)
