

HOUSE No. 3393

By Mr. King of Boston, petition of Melvin H. King that the Executive office of Communities and Development be prohibited from entering into contracts providing for the redevelopment project of the Copley Square Plaza Development in the city of Boston. Urban Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE COPLEY SQUARE PLAZA DEVELOPMENT, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, the
2 executive office of communities and development is hereby prohi-
3 bited from entering into contracts providing for the urban redevel-
4 opment project known as the Copley Square Plaza Development,
5 in the Back Bay section of the city of Boston, said area being
6 bounded by the Central Railroad tracks, Huntington Avenue, and
7 West Newton Street. The Massachusetts Turnpike Authority is
8 hereby prohibited from entering into any contracts relative to
9 property which it owns within said geographic area.
