

SECTION 3. No assessment shall be levied upon said town of Georgetown on account of membership in the Ipswich River Watershed District after June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Chap. 17. AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF NORTHERN NORFOLK.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out in *Class IV*, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 815 of the acts of 1970, the line reading "district court of northern Norfolk," and by inserting in *Class V*, as so appearing, after the line reading "district court of East Norfolk," the following line: — district court of northern Norfolk.,

Chap. 18. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 585 of the acts of 1970, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Assistant clerks with salaries payable by the county may be appointed in the central district court of northern Essex, the municipal court of the Charlestown district, the municipal court of the Brighton district, the district court of western Hampden, the district court of Newton, the district court of northern Norfolk, the district court of Chicopee, the municipal court of Brookline, the district court of Fitchburg, the first district court of southern Middlesex, the first district court of Barnstable, the second district court of Barnstable, the district court of western Norfolk, the fourth district court of Bristol, the third district court of Plymouth, the fourth district court of Plymouth, the district court of Peabody, the first district court of northern Worcester, the first district court of northern Middlesex and in courts the judicial districts of which have, according to national or state census last preceding, a population of sixty thousand or more.

Chap. 19. AN ACT INCREASING THE FEES FOR DOG LICENSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 139 of chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 35 of the acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The fee for every license shall, except as otherwise provided, be three dollars for a male dog and six dollars for a female dog, unless a certificate of a registered veterinarian who performed the operation that said female dog has been spayed and has thereby been deprived of the power of propagation has been shown to the town clerk, in which case the fee shall be three dollars.
