### AN ACT

Concerning the First District Court of Bristol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :*

1 SECTION 1. The special justice of the first district  
2 court of Bristol, holding a session of said court at  
3 Attleborough, under the provisions of chapter one  
4 hundred and eighty-nine of the acts of the year  
5 eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, may issue,  
6 under his own hand and seal, all mittimuses or  
7 other warrants which may be necessary or proper in  
8 execution of the judgments rendered or sentences  
9 imposed by said justice.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
