AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE CHARTER COMMISSION NOW EXISTENT IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO SUBMIT ITS PRELIMINARY AND FINAL REPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (b) and (c) of
2 section nine of chapter forty-three B of the General Laws, the
3 charter commission now existent in the city of Medford may
4 submit its final report as required by said subsection (b) within nine
5 months after its election and its final report as required by said
6 subsection (c) within eleven months of its election.
