RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Improvements at the State Normal School at Worcester.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding four
3 thousand five hundred dollars, for the purpose of grading
4 and improving the grounds, and for completing a wall
5 around said grounds, at the State Normal School at
6 Worcester, to be expended under the direction of the
7 state board of education.
