AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSTRUCTIONS ON SCHOOL BUS EVACUATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 3 of chapter 552 of the acts of 1976, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out clause (15) and inserting in place
4 thereof the following clause: —

5 (15) During each school year each pupil transported in a school
6 bus shall receive classroom instruction in safe riding practices and
7 participate at least twice in on-bus emergency evacuation drills; the
8 responsibility to provide classroom instruction in safe riding prac-
9 tices and to supervise and conduct on-bus evacuations shall be
10 borne by the receiving school district or authority.
