AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF OUTDOOR RECEPTACLES OR CONTAINERS FOR BURNING OF COMBUSTIBLE SUBSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 48 of the General Laws shall be amended by
2 adding a new section 13A as follows: —
3 *Section 13A.* All outdoor receptacles or containers, herein
4 called incinerators, used for the burning of combustible sub-
5 stances shall be of non-combustible material, shall be placed
6 at least fifteen feet from any structure and so located and
7 securely covered or screened that no building, grass, brush or
8 forest can be ignited; provided, that an incinerator which is
9 not so made, located and covered or screened shall be found
10 to be an open air fire subject to the provisions of section
11 thirteen of this chapter.
