The committee on BILLS IN THE THIRD READING to whom was recommitted the bill RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES BY LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITIES (HOUSE NO. 6156), reports, recommending that the same be amended by substituting in part therefor a NEW DRAFT entitled "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER AND THE TOWNS OF DENNIS, PALMER AND DRACUT TO ISSUE ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES." (Senate, No. 2328) and that, when so amended, the same will be correctly drawn.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER AND THE TOWNS OF DENNIS, PALMER AND DRACUT TO ISSUE ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Dennis is hereby
4 authorized to issue to Finley's Y.D. Store, Inc., a license under
5 section fifteen, and the licensing authority of the town of
6 Palmer is hereby authorized to issue to J.F. Inc., d/b/a One
7 Stop a license under section fifteen of said chapter one hun-
8 dred thirty-eight for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to
9 be drunk on the premises, which licenses shall be subject to
10 and have the benefit of said chapter one hundred thirty-eight,
11 excepting the provisions of said section seventeen; provided,
12 however, that the number of seasonal licenses for the sale of
13 all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises
14 authorized for each said town to issue under the provisions of
15 said section seventeen shall be reduced by one license.

16 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of
17 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the
18 licensing authority of the city of Gloucester is hereby authoriz-
19 ed to issue to Pat's Center Grocery and Package Store, Inc.,
20 a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk
21 on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said
22 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be sub-
23 ject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-
24 eight except said section seventeen; provided, however, that
25 said licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said
26 license within one year after the date of issuance of such
27 license; provided, further, that if the holder of said license is
28 a corporation, said licensing authority shall not approve the
29 transfer, pledging or issuance of shares of stock of such cor-

30 poration within one year after the date of issuance of said
31 license; and provided further, that the number of seasonal
32 licenses for sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on
33 the premises under the provisions of said section seventeen
34 shall be reduced by one such license.

35 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of
36 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the
37 licensing authority of the town of Dracut is hereby authorized
38 to issue to Dracut Town Variety a license for the sale of all
39 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the
40 provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and
41 thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all provisions of
42 said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section
43 seventeen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
