AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE TERM OF LICENSES TO OPERATE ROOMING HOUSES SHALL BE FROM MAY FIRST TO APRIL THIRTIETH OF EACH YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 23 and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing section: —

4 *Section 23.* Licensing authorities may grant licenses for
5 lodging houses which shall be for the period of May first to
6 April thirtieth of each year, and shall charge for each license
7 such fee, not exceeding two dollars, as the city council or select-
8 men may establish, otherwise the same shall be granted without
9 charge.
