SPECIAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDING LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE FOR REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE OBSERVANCE OF THE FORTY-FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.

Under the provisions of chapter 7, section 7, of the General Laws, I submit herewith a resolve providing for representation of the Commonwealth on the occasion of the observance of the forty-fifth anniversary of the Boston Juvenile Court to be held in Boston in February 1952.

The importance of this event in observing the establishment, by law, of the first juvenile care in the United States warrants an expenditure on the part of the Commonwealth to be properly represented.

I recommend that the sum of \$2,000 be appropriated under the enclosed resolve. In view of the necessity of providing the officials of the court, in charge of the ob-

servance, knowledge as to available funds, may I request that the resolve be transmitted for immediate consideration to the Ways and Means Committee.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE OBSERVANCE OF THE FORTY-FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN FEBRUARY OF THE CURRENT YEAR.

1 *Resolved*, That in order that the commonwealth may
2 be properly represented on the occasion of the ob-
3 servance of the forty-fifth anniversary of the Boston
4 juvenile court to be held in the city of Boston in
5 February of the current year and to insure in ar-
6 ranging events in connection therewith, proper co-
7 operation between the officials of the Boston juvenile
8 court and the commonwealth, after an appropriation
9 has been made therefor there may be expended, with
10 the approval and under the direction of the governor
11 and council, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars.
