AN ACT PROVIDING FOR EXTENSION OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN LAW, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 111C of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in paragraph two, line 5, by changing the words
3 "seventy-seven" to "eighty".
