AN ACT RELIEVING THE CITY OF QUINCY AND THE TOWNS OF BRAINTREE AND WEYMOUTH FROM THE OBLIGATION OF PAYING THE COMPENSATION OF THE DRAW-TENDERS EMPLOYED AT THE NEW HIGH LEVEL BRIDGE OVER THE WEYMOUTH FORE RIVER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section four of chapter three hundred and forty-  
2 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-  
3 three is hereby amended by striking out all after the  
4 word "highway", in the sixth line, — so as to read  
5 as follows: — *Section 4.* When the work authorized  
6 herein shall have been completed, any new location  
7 of the Fore River Railroad Corporation established  
8 hereunder shall be conveyed to it by the common-  
9 wealth, and the permanent bridge referred to in  
10 section one, with its abutments and draw, shall be-  
11 come and be maintained as a state highway.
