To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:


Pursuant to the provisions of Article II, Section 8, Paragraph 1, Clause (2) of the Amendments to the Constitution, as amended by Article LXXXIX, we are filing for your consideration the attached legislation entitled, "An Act Repealing the Law Authorizing the Town of Holbrook to Establish a Betterment Reserve Fund."

St. 1998, c. 443, is a special act, filed on behalf of the Town of Holbrook, authorizing the establishment of a betterment reserve fund. Representatives Mariano and Sullivan, Senator Morrissey and the Holbrook Board of Selectmen ask that the 1998 Act be repealed because the Town has determined not to establish such a fund.

AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HOLBROOK TO ESTABLISH A BETTERMENT RESERVE FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and forty-three of the acts
- 2 of nineteen hundred and ninety-eight is hereby repealed.
  
- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
