## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REIMBURSEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE SECOND INJURY FUND, SO-CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 37 of chapter one  
2 hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws, as most recently  
3 amended by section two of chapter eight hundred and fifty-five of  
4 the Acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-three, is hereby further  
5 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place  
6 thereof the following sentence: — Such insurer or self-insurer shall,  
7 however, be reimbursed by the state treasurer from the fund  
8 created by section sixty-five for all compensation subsequent to  
9 that paid for the first one hundred and four weeks of disability.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of section 37 of chapter  
2 one hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws, as most recently  
3 amended by section two of chapter eight hundred and fifty-five of  
4 the Acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-three, is hereby further  
5 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place  
6 thereof the following sentence: — Such insurer or self-insurer shall,  
7 however, be reimbursed by the state treasurer from the fund  
8 created by section sixty-five for all compensation paid in excess of  
9 that paid for the first one hundred and four weeks.
