RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PRESENT STATUTES OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING AND QUALIFICATIONS OF INSURANCE AGENTS AND BROKERS.

1 *Resolved*, that a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2 bers of the Senate, three members of the House of Represent-  
3 atives, the Commissioner of Insurance or his designee, and six  
4 persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom shall  
5 be a member of the Massachusetts Association of Life Under-  
6 writers, one of whom shall be a member of the Independent  
7 Insurance Agents of Massachusetts, is hereby established for  
8 the purpose of making an investigation and study of the pro-  
9 visions of general laws Chapter 175, Section 163A as to the  
10 licensing and qualifications of insurance agents and brokers  
11 and continuing educational requirements. Said commission  
12 subject to appropriation may hire research and clerical em-  
13 ployees and shall file its report and recommendations on or  
14 before the first Wednesday in December, 1977.
