AN ACT

To repeal existing Legislation which makes it Compulsory for Clerks and Assistant Clerks of District and Municipal Courts to be retired at the Age of Seventy Years.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Any and all existing legislation making
- 2 compulsory the retirement of clerks and assistant clerks
- 3 of district and municipal courts at the age of seventy
- 4 years is hereby repealed.
- 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
