### RESOLVE

Relative to the Fish Hatching Station at Plymouth, in the State of New Hampshire, now used and managed by said State and this Commonwealth in common.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor and council are hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to arrange with the authorities  
3 of the state of New Hampshire for ending the joint ten-  
4 ancy of the fish hatching station at Plymouth, in said  
5 state, now used and managed by the state of New Hamp-  
6 shire and this Commonwealth in common, and may pur-  
7 chase or dispose of the same as they may deem best for  
8 the interests of this Commonwealth. The governor is  
9 hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury  
10 for such sum as may be required for this purpose, to be  
11 paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise  
12 appropriated.
