AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TEACHERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE STATE-BOSTON RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL BE ENTITLED TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR PRIOR SERVICE AS A CADET.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the  
2 contrary, any teacher who is a member of the State-Boston  
3 retirement system shall be entitled to creditable service for  
4 any previous service as a cadet in said city, provided that the  
5 teacher pays into the annuity savings fund a sum equal to five  
6 per cent of his compensation earned while serving as a cadet.
