AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ADAMS TO ACCEPT SEWERAGE FROM THE HOOSAC VALLEY REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE TOWN OF CHESHIRE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Adams is hereby authorized to enter  
2 into an agreement with the Hoosac Valley regional high school  
3 district for the tie-in of the sewerage system of the Hoosac  
4 Valley regional high school located in the town of Cheshire with  
5 the sewerage system of the said town of Adams for the purpose  
6 of disposing of the waste and sewerage of said school

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
