

*Chap. 187* AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN CLERKS AND PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL CLERICAL ASSISTANCE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Salaries of clerks established.

SECTION 1. The insurance commissioner may employ in the discharge of the duties of his department, a first clerk at an annual salary of two thousand dollars, a second clerk at an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, and a third clerk at an annual salary of twelve hundred dollars, and such additional clerks and other assistants as may be necessary for the despatch of public business at an expense not exceeding eight thousand dollars a year.

SECTION 2. Section four of chapter one hundred and nineteen of the Public Statutes is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 188* AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE FIRST PARISH IN MEDWAY TO PARISH OF THE CHURCH OF CHRIST IN MILLIS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Name changed.

SECTION 1. The society known as the First Parish in Medway shall hereafter be called and known as the Parish of the Church of Christ in Millis.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 189* AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE JUDGE OF THE PROBATE COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF HAMPDEN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Salary established.

SECTION 1. The judge of the probate court for the county of Hampden shall receive an annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 190* AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN HAMPDEN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

District court of western Hampden.

SECTION 1. The towns of Westfield, Chester, Granville, Southwick, Russell, Blandford, Tolland and Montgomery shall constitute a judicial district under the jurisdiction of a court to be called the district court of western Hampden. Said court shall have a seal.
