
The Commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAM) certifies that an emergency exists, as defined in G. L. c. 7, § 40E, for the following reasons:

The Committee for Public Counsel Services (CPC) employs public defenders who currently provide legal representation to 10% of indigent defendants in criminal and certain civil proceedings within the Commonwealth. Pursuant to § 2 of chapter 68 of the Acts of 2011, CPC must develop and implement a plan in which no less than 25% of indigent defendants in criminal and certain civil proceedings are represented by a public defender by the end of Fiscal Year 2012. CPC expects to hire approximately 346 staff in order to comply with § 2 of chapter 68 of the Acts of 2011.

CPC's scope of service is diverse and provides for the needs of many of the Commonwealth's litigants. A Constitutional crisis could occur if these services are not provided in a timely and effective manner. To ensure that CPC can carry-out CPC's mission to provide constitutionally mandated legal services to the poor and comply with § 2 of chapter 68 of the Acts of 2011, there is a need to procure office space that can be occupied expeditiously. DCAM has been unable to identify state-owned space for the expeditious use of CPC.

DCAM is issuing Invitations for Proposals on behalf of CPC for office space in some or all of the following communities : Barnstable, Boston (downtown), Brockton, Fall River, Framingham, Greenfield, Hadley, Lowell, Malden, Medford, New Bedford, Northampton, Pittsfield, Quincy, Roxbury, Salem, Springfield, Waltham, and Worcester, notice of which will be published in the Central Register. The Commissioner has determined that suitable space that can be occupied expeditiously cannot be procured without waiving the statutorily required advertising. Therefore the Commissioner waives the advertising periods set forth in G. L. c 7, § 40H and the requirement for a proposal-submission deadline. Notice will be placed in the Central Register and in a newspaper with a circulation sufficient to inform the people of the affected localities and, to facilitate timely occupancy by CPC, proposals may be opened upon receipt.

Dear Commissioner Cornelison:

I am requesting your certification of an emergency situation at the Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) branch in Danvers and your waiver of the statutory advertising requirement in connection with the acquisition of leased space. The RMV has reviewed the emergency procurement provision under G.L. c. 30B § 8 and G.L. c. 7 § 40E and believes the situation at the Danvers branch qualifies as an emergency under those provisions.


The HVAC system at this location stopped functioning on May 25, 2012. MassDOT provided a portable air conditioning system that is expected to adequately cool the premises throughout the summer months, but heating is unavailable. The landlord has not repaired the HVAC system serving the premises and has not indicated that the system will be repaired or replaced. Heating will be required in as little as two months and an emergency declaration is needed if the RMV is to occupy new leased space by the fall of 2012.

This branch serves the Northeast corner of the Commonwealth and supports 15,000 transactions per month. It is imperative that the RMV continue to operate a facility that serves the communities in this region. If there is no facility serving these communities, the customer base will utilize branches located in Haverhill, Revere, and Wilmington. These branches are not sized or equipped to accommodate such an increase in customer volume and we believe that this would result in health and safety issues at these locations.

The RMV requests that DCAM approve an emergency procurement to expedite the immediate relocation of the Danvers branch. RMV has included a Form 1 and would like to work with your team to develop a generic Request for Proposals (RFP) that would maximize the RMV's options. The RMV is seeking 3,000 to 8,000 usable square feet of space in Danvers, Beverly, Georgetown, Hamilton, Peabody, and Wenham for a term of five years. It is our hope that we can procure space that meets the needs of the RMV as expressed in the RFP, but would like flexibility in the term and other requirements of the RFP to ensure that we are able to take occupancy of suitable space within our limited time-frame. We believe this will allow procurement of leased space in an abbreviated time-frame and allow us to protect the integrity of our operations and the health and safety of our employees and customers.
