AN ACT MANDATING REIMBURSEMENT OF 100% FOR EXPENDITURES BY CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary notwithstanding, the department of education
3 shall certify and the state treasurer shall pay to every city
4 and town 100% of its entitlement of chapter 74 expenditures
5 for approved vocational education programs.

1 SECTION 2. Any state official or officer who by his action as
2 an official of the state department of education causes said
3 reimbursements to be less than the 100% referred to in sec-
4 tion one, shall be punished by removal from office by the
5 state board of education.
