AN ACT TO PROVIDE TREATMENT FOR POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by adding
3 the following paragraph: —

4 He shall make available appropriate treatment services for
5 delayed stress syndrome to combat veterans referred by a court
6 or incarcerated in state or county correctional institutions.
