

Chap. 85. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND PERMITS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXCAVATING MINERALS.

Resolved, That the department of natural resources and the department of public works, acting jointly, are hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered 4220, pertaining to the issuance of licenses and permits by the department of natural resources for the purpose of excavating minerals. Said departments shall report to the general court the results of their investigation and study, and their recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry their recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Chap. 86. RESOLVE CONTINUING THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE RETIREMENT LAW COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CERTAIN BENEFITS PROVIDED FOR WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS UNDER THE RETIREMENT LAW AND THE FEASIBILITY OF INCREASING SUCH BENEFITS.

Resolved, That the retirement law commission is hereby authorized and directed to continue the investigation and study authorized by chapter twenty-four of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight. Said commission shall file its final report not later than the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Chap. 87. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE PROBLEMS OF SAFETY FOR THE AGED.

Resolved, That a special commission, to consist of three members of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, the commissioner of public safety, and the commissioner of public health, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom shall be a representative of a charitable organization providing living accommodations for the elderly, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the problems of the aged, particularly as related to safety measures for those elderly persons living in private housing and institutions.

Chap. 88. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES RELATIVE TO THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN LAND FOR CONSERVATION PURPOSES.

Resolved, That the department of natural resources is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of the subject
