An Act extending the Benefits of the Law providing for State Military Aid and Soldiers' Relief to the Widows and Dependents of Veterans of the Mexican Border Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of chapter one hundred and fifteen
2 of the General Laws relating to state and military
3 aid and soldiers' relief are hereby extended to apply
4 to the widows and dependents of veterans of the
5 Mexican border service.
