AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROCKTON TO RETIRE  
AND PAY A PENSION TO CHARLES POSKUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the pub-  
2 lic good, the city of Brockton is hereby authorized to  
3 retire and pay a pension to Charles Poskus, a city  
4 laborer, who is now totally and permanently disabled  
5 by reason of injuries sustained in the line of duty while  
6 employed as a laborer in the service of said city. The  
7 amount of such pension per annum shall equal one  
8 half of his annual rate of regular compensation at the  
9 time of his termination of service, and shall be paid in  
10 equal monthly instalments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,  
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not other-  
4 wise.
