RESOLVE

To authorize the Payment of an Annuity to Fannie S. Butler through the Mayor of the City of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth to the mayor of the city
3 of Boston an annuity of two hundred and fifty dollars, to
4 be expended by the said mayor for the benefit of Fannie
5 S. Butler, granddaughter of the late Sylvia Sepit Thomas
6 and daughter of the late Mary Angeline Thomas Butler,
7 members of the Wampanoag tribe of Indians, for the rest
8 of her natural life, beginning with the first day of De-
9 cember in the year nineteen hundred and sixteen, and
10 payable in equal quarterly instalments.

11 Chapter one hundred and seventeen of the resolves of
12 the year nineteen hundred and fourteen is hereby
13 repealed.
