The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING UNIFORM PRIMARY PROCEDURES FOR UNENROLLED VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37 of Chapter 53 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by Chapter 475 of 1993, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: —

5 If the voter was unenrolled prior to the selection of a party
6 ballot he shall continue to be unenrolled and shall be recorded as
7 unenrolled in the current annual register of voters.

1 SECTION 2. Section 37A of said chapter, as so amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the fifth sentence and
3 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —

4 If the voter was unenrolled prior to the selection of a party
5 ballot he shall continue to be unenrolled and shall be recorded as
6 unenrolled in the current annual register of voters.

1 SECTION 3. Section 38 of said chapter, as so amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence.

1 SECTION 4. Said section of said chapter, as so amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the last four sentences.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
