## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT AN INDOOR HOCKEY AND SKATING RINK ON CERTAIN PARK LAND IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, AND AUTHORIZING SAID CITY TO CONVEY SUCH LAND TO THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, acting through  
2 its division of waterways and administration of public  
3 beaches, is hereby authorized and directed to construct an  
4 indoor hockey and skating rink in the city of Springfield  
5 on land described in section two of this act and thereafter  
6 to maintain the same.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of enabling the department  
2 of public works to construct the indoor hockey and skating  
3 rink as provided in section one, the city of Springfield with  
4 the approval of its park commission and upon such terms  
5 and conditions as are hereinafter specified, is hereby author-  
6 ized to convey to the commonwealth a certain parcel of  
7 park land owned by the city and located therein bounded  
8 and described as follows:—

9 Starting at a point 170 feet south and on an azimuth of  
10  $83^{\circ}-23'-33''$  E from a stone bound located at the intersection  
11 of land now or formerly of Mrs. Blanch Q. Carey, thence at an  
12 angle of 90 degrees for a distance of 265 feet on an azimuth of  
13  $S86^{\circ}-36'-27''$  W to a point, thence at an angle of 90 degrees  
14 for a distance of 70' on an azimuth of  $N3^{\circ}-23'-33''$  W to a  
15 point, thence at an angle of 90 degrees for a distance of 265  
16 feet at an azimuth of  $N86^{\circ}-36'-27''$  E to a point, located on  
17 the westerly side of Roosevelt Avenue, thence northerly  
18 along Roosevelt Avenue for a distance of 190 feet to the  
19 starting point. Approximately 2.8 acres.

20 Said conveyance may be made upon such terms and condi-  
21 tions as may be agreed upon by said city and the department  
22 of public works provided, however, jurisdiction in and over  
23 said land shall revert to and revest in said city whenever  
24 such land shall cease to be used for the purpose set forth  
25 in this section.

1 SECTION 3. To meet the expenditures necessary in carrying  
2 out the provisions of this act the department of public  
3 works may make use of funds available under the provisions  
4 of chapter six hundred and thirty-two of the acts of nine-  
5 teen hundred and sixty-six. The provisions of said chapter  
6 six hundred and thirty-two, except for section two thereof,  
7 shall apply to the construction and maintenance of said rink.

1 SECTION 4. The provisions of section two shall take affect  
2 upon its acceptance by the city of Springfield.
