AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LISTING AND VOTING RIGHTS
OF VETERANS IN THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 51 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph,
3 as amended by chapter 26 of the acts of 1947, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following:—

5 Any veteran in the soldiers' home in Chelsea shall
6 have the same right as any other resident of that
7 city to be assessed and to vote therein; provided,
8 that such veteran has been an inmate of said home
9 for a period of not less than one year.
