AN ACT

Empowering Women to hold the Office of Assistant Town and City Clerk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No person shall be deemed ineligible to
2 hold the office of assistant town or city clerk by reason
3 of sex.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
