AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HOLDING AND CONDUCTING OF DOG RACES UNDER THE PARI-MUTUEL OR CERTIFICATE SYSTEM OF BETTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
