AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor of the city of New Bedford
2 shall receive for his services such salary as the city
3 council thereof by ordinance shall determine not
4 exceeding sixty-five hundred dollars. The city coun-
5 cil of said city may, by a two thirds vote of all its
6 members taken by call of the yeas and nays, establish
7 a salary for its members not exceeding one thousand
8 dollars each.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section sixty-two
2 of chapter forty-three of the General Laws shall not
3 apply in said city.
