SENATE No. 1344

By Mr. Webber, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1344) of Peter C. Webber and Daniel E. Bosley for legislation to extend reciprocity to the State of New York and former members of the New York State Public Pension System who reside in the Commonwealth. Public Service.

AN ACT EXTENDING RECIPROCITY TO THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND FORMER MEMBERS OF THE NEW YORK STATE PUBLIC PENSION SYSTEM WHO RESIDE IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended in the first paragraph of subsection B(a) (4), after
3 the words "political subdivision thereof", by inserting the
4 following words: — except the state of New York.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 3 of said Chapter 62 is hereby
2 further amended in subsection B(a) (4) by adding at the end
3 thereof the following: —

4 For New York State annuity, pension, endowment or
5 retirement funds, the Part B adjusted gross income shall be
6 reduced in the above manner for benefits not in excess of twenty
7 thousand dollars received by an individual who has attained the
8 age of fifty-nine and one-half.
