Resolutions memorializing Congress to require that Preference be given to Citizens of the United States in Employment on Unemployment Relief Projects that are financed by Federal Funds.

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts
2 urges Congress to enact legislation or to otherwise
3 take appropriate action to require that preference
4 shall be given to citizens of the United States in em-
5 ployment on unemployment relief projects that are
6 financed in whole or in part by federal funds; and be
7 it further

8 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Commonwealth
9 forthwith send copies of these Resolutions to the
10 President of the United States and to the Members of
11 Congress from this Commonwealth.
