By Mr. Wall of Lawrence, petition of William X. Wall that the Trustees of the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts be authorized to construct a two hundred bed soldiers' home in the county of Essex. Military Affairs and Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Wassachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

An Act providing for a soldiers' home in essex county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The board of trustees of the Soldiers'
- 2 Home in Massachusetts is hereby authorized and di-
- 3 rected to construct in an appropriate location in Essex
- 4 county a two hundred bed soldiers' home whereat
- 5 hospital and domiciliary care shall be provided in like
- 6 manner as that provided at the soldiers' home main-
- 7 tained by said board in the city of Chelsea. The
- 8 eligibility of persons for admission to and treatment
- 9 at the soldiers' home provided for by this act shall be
- 10 governed by the eligibility requirements pertaining to
- 11 admissions to and treatment at said home in the city
- 12 of Chelsea.
 - 1 Section 2. Said board of trustees shall have the
 - 2 management and control of the home provided for

- 3 by this act, and for said purposes shall have the same
- 4 powers and perform the same duties as are vested and
- 5 imposed in the trustees of state hospitals under the
- 6 provisions of chapter one hundred and twenty-three,
- 7 so far as applicable.
- 1 Section 3. For the purpose of constructing, fur-
- 2 nishing and equipping the home provided for by this
- 3 act, there may be expended such sums as may here-
- 4 after be appropriated therefor.
