AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REVOCATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSES OF PERSONS ADJUDGED DELINQUENTS BY REASON OF VIOLATIONS OF NARCOTIC LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "guilty" in
3 subsection (1) (d) the following words:—or adjudged a
4 delinquent child in accordance with the provisions of section
5 fifty-eight B of chapter one hundred and nineteen.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 24 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of
3 subsection (2) (b) the following sentence:—For the pur-
4 poses of subdivision (2) of this section, a person shall be
5 deemed to have been convicted if he pleaded guilty or nolo
6 contendere or was found or adjudged guilty or was adjudged
7 a delinquent child in accordance with the provisions of sec-
8 tion fifty-eight B of chapter one hundred and nineteen by a
9 court of competent jurisdiction, whether or not he was placed
10 on probation, without sentence, or under a suspended sen-
11 tence, or the case was placed on file.
